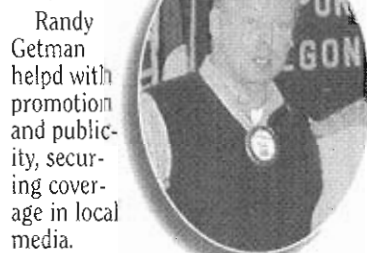
July 31 Program Focuses on Our Club's "Jobseekers" Efforts
