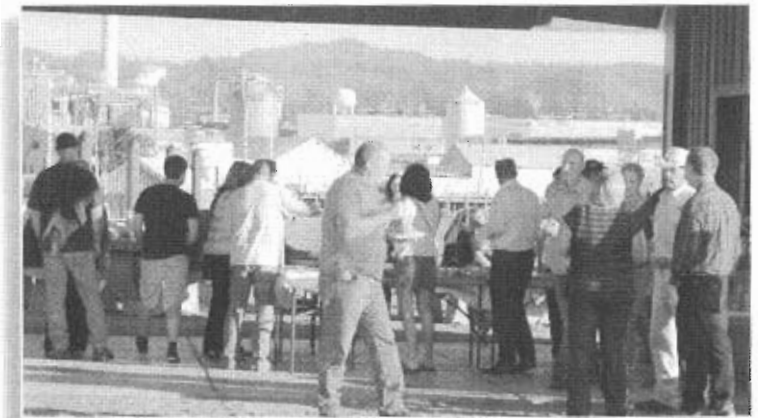

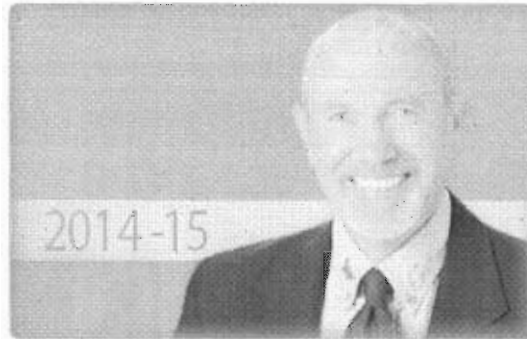


Rotarians and food just seem to naturally go together... Debra Smith won the "bean cassarole" contest but no one knows what her prize was.

Jack Samuel Burri

1933 - 2014

We are sad to report the passing of Jack Burri, who served as our club's president during the Rotary year 1990-1991.

Jack was known for his sense of humor and, more personally, for the fact that he held dual citizenship (USA and Switzerland).

He also assembled, and spear-headed, one of our club's most successful, and profitable, fund-raisers. We hosted the CycleOregon group when the end of their trail in 1991 was Newport. We provided lodging for the camping cyclists at Yaquina View School and fed them seafood lasagna, prepared and dished up by our members and their spouses.

One of the highlights for the riders was 'dipping their front wheels in the Pacific ocean', signifying the end of their ride that year... quite a ritual to behold.

Jack was vice principal of Newport Middle School and principal of Waldport High School; he enjoyed fishing, gardening and travel.

Jack is survived by his partner, Mary Jo Peterson, his brother, Fred, sons Michael and Scott, and daughter, Karen, along with four grandsons and his former wife of 44 years, Jacquelyn.
