Assistant Governor Carol Ruggeri

Assistant Governor Carol Ruggeri spoke with our Club about The Lincoln County Foundation. The Foundation is a non-profit corporation established by a group of Lincoln County residents in 1965 to serve as an agency to receive and administer funds and other property contributed for any civic, educational, charitable or religious purpose, and particularly to assist, encourage and promote the welfare and well-being of the youth of Lincoln County, Oregon.

The governing body of the Lincoln Foundation is a Board of Directors comprised of a group of nine volunteer representative citizens of Lincoln County. Two of the directors are appointed by the Newport Rotary Club, two by the Toledo Rotary Club, one by the Lincoln County School District Board of Directors, one by the Lincoln County Court Commissioners. These six directors appoint three-at-large directors to represent all area of the county. Rotarians Julie Hanrahan and Marcia Buckley currently serve as the President and Vice President respectively.

The principal of gifts that are to be continuing or endowment funds are currently being invested with Edward Jones Investment Securities in a portfolio. The portfolio currently consists of over \$4 million. A donation may be unrestricted (being left entirely to the discretion of the Board of Directors) or restricted (when a contributor may specify their charitable or benevolent objectives either broadly or in detail. Permanent benefits to the community are made possible through the combination of the many civic, educational, charitable and religious bequests into one fund. Gifts to which restrictions as to use of income or principle have been attached are kept in separate funds and the income and principle are expended only for the purposes and to the extent designated by the donor.
