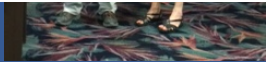

Lieutenant Curtis Landers introduced Deputy Jeremy Gautney and his partner, Deputy Bonni, last week and shared with us the added benefits of having a K-9 unit in the county.

Deputy Gautney explained that Bonni provides searches (mostly to human scent), apprehension and tracking, as well as deputy protection. The protection is important as many times the nearest backup to a deputy can be many miles away. The deputies were kind enough to give us a demonstration of Bonni's abilities, training, manner and beauty.

Lt. Landers explained that Deputy Gautney came to them with the idea of the K-9 unit and did much of the needed research in obtaining the dog and was ultimately selected as the handler. Both deputies undergo a required 16 hours per month training to maintain certifications, as well as routine patrol shifts, visits to schools and other presentations in their busy schedules. Bonni is from the Czech Republic and finished her training in October 2015. She speaks only Czech and answers to 10-12 commands. She is now on duty and lives with Deputy Gautney, his wife, two children and two other dogs.
